PHASE UPDATES

Interlachen Bluff & Interlachen Circle

As of today, the utility crews have completed installing water and sewer upgrades on both streets.

Next week grading crews will continue working on your streets by removing the old roadbed. Please be aware of the truck traffic involved with the grading process. Crews will notify you prior to working in front of your driveway because you may not be able to access your driveway during the excavation. If need be, they will arrange a place for you to park. By the end of the day you will have access to your driveway. Feel free to talk with the crew onsite if you have questions or concerns about access.

Later next week, concrete crews will move on site. They will begin installing curb and gutter, concrete aprons and restoring concrete driveways. You will be notified by an orange flyer in your front door. This flyer will have instructions on where to park your car, and contain information on the 7-day curing period for the new concrete. During this time, you will need to park on the street in front of your home while the new concrete hardens for 7 days. Please watch your front door for this notice. Crews will place this a day in advance to keep you informed of where/when to move your car out and where to park.

Omann Brothers, Inc. will have someone available to water the road surface over the weekend as needed to help keep the dust down.

OVERALL WEEKLY UPDATES
