W. 70th Street (TH100 to France Avenue) Reconstruction Project

Dear Residents:

After a long construction season 70th Street is now open to traffic. Thank you so much for your patience and cooperation during this project.

Overall Updates

All Phases

(Streets between TH 100 and France Avenue)

Signal at West Shore Drive

The signal at West Shore Drive is operating as flashing red currently. Please keep in mind, this means the intersection should be treated as a stop condition. The signal will operate in this manner even though the roadway is open to traffic. The signal is scheduled to operate in the normal condition starting November 15.

Pedestrian Flasher Signal at Wooddale

The pedestrian flasher at Wooddale has been placed, but is not yet operational. We anticipate the flasher system will be operational on November 15. In the meantime, the contractor will bag the pedestrian flasher system to indicate to pedestrians and vehicles that it is not yet functioning as designed.

Metro Transit Bus Service

Starting Monday November 15 Metro Transit bus service will resume on 70th Street.

Increased Police Presence

The new speed limit on 70th Street is 25 mph (20 mph in the school zone). Expect additional police presence along the roadway.
